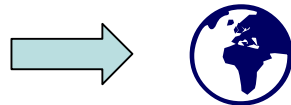

# Better Knowledge

## I. Registration

- **Counselling and auditing** to develop registers  
(coll. with IARC, GRELL, NCI, MECC...)
- **Training** of registrars  
in cooperation IARC, GRELL, in several languages  
in regions where the need is expressed
- **Software:** Abstract +, hospital based registration  
in Spanish, coll. with CDC and IARC,  
compatible with CanReg IARC software

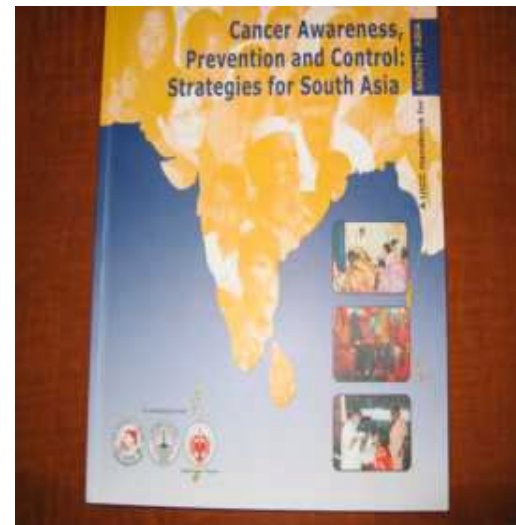
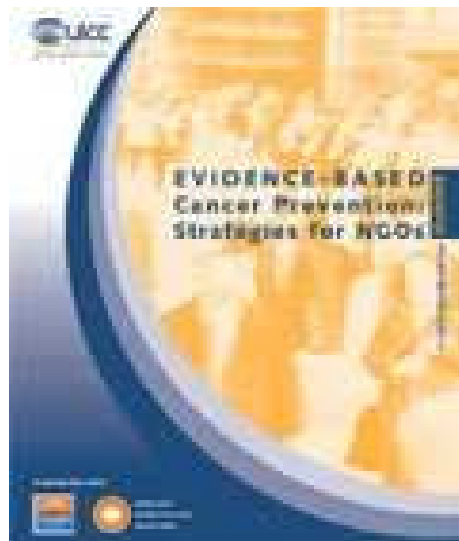

### **A New handbook series:**

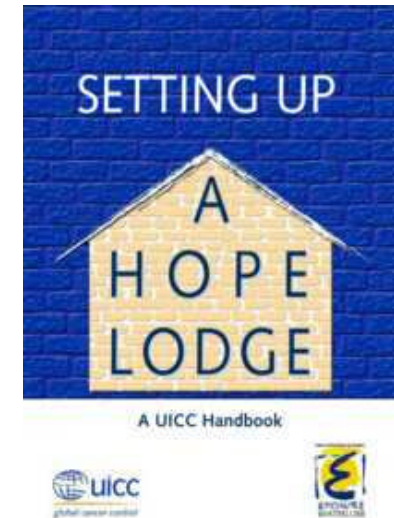

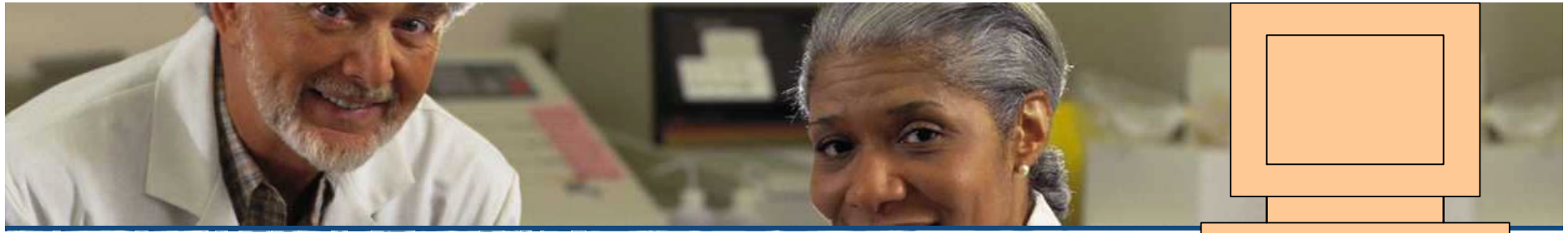
