Submit an abstract of one page on the template provided at www.eso.net or on the application form describing a clinical case related to one of the subjects of the Masterclass (lung, colorectal, breast, lymphoma gynaecological and prostate cancers). You will have to present your case at the Masterclass in format of a clinical grand round discussion. Please provide a straightforward a case of your daily clinical practice - no uncommon or extremely rare case. A maximum of 10 slides will be permitted containing:

- Diagnostic considerations
- Treatment
- Results, follow-up
- At least three questions proposed for discussion with the faculty

Participants will be asked to bring their personal laptop or tablet (wireless enabled) to the masterclass as an event dedicated-website will be created and all questionnaires and certificates will be accessible only from there. Any potential problems with meeting this request should be communicated to the secretariat as part of the application process.
